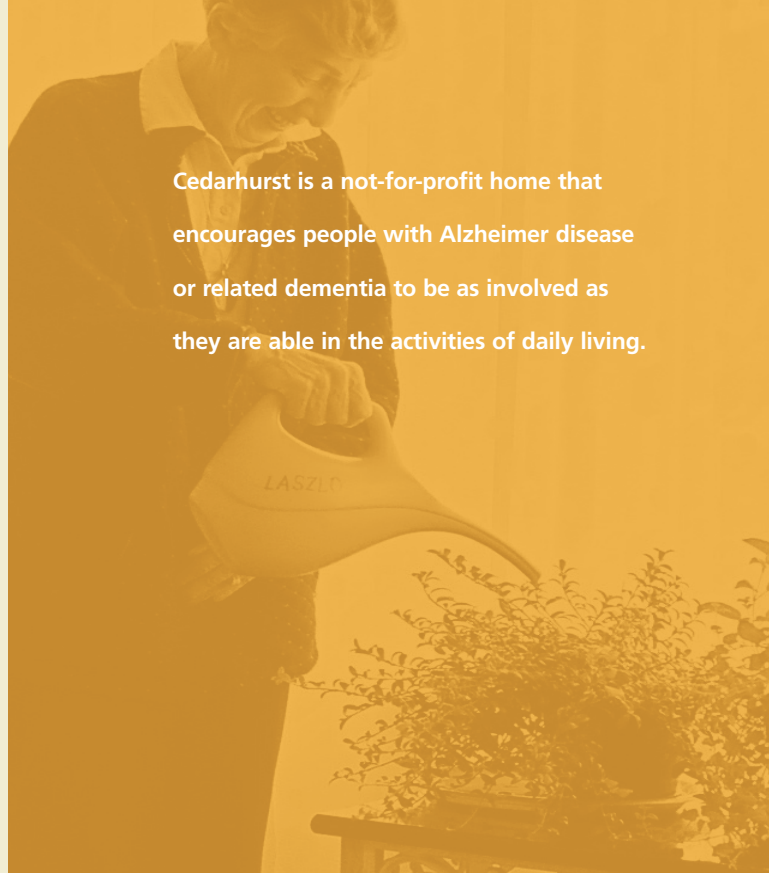

Cedarhurst is a not-for-profit home that encourages people with Alzheimer disease or related dementia to be as involved as they are able in the activities of daily living.



Attention to Each Individual

Very high ratio of staff to residents fosters respect for residents' former daily rhythms and their dignity

Caring, specially trained staff who understand dementia and its effects on behaviour encourage the residents to be as involved as they are able in the activities of daily living. Groups of six residents are each assisted by a full-time personal support worker and other staff and volunteers.

Staff plan daily activities designed to stimulate and respond to the resident's individual interests and abilities. Small and large group activities, such as gardening, games, discussions and outings and other programming to support memory and cognitive functioning are organized seven days a week.

We encourage families to participate in all decisions pertaining to the care of their relative. Family members are welcome to visit any time and to participate in any or all activities.

Our care providers are specially trained personal support workers from SPRINT

(Senior Peoples' Resources in North Toronto Inc.), a United Way agency which has been active in the community since 1983, providing community services to help seniors and people with disabilities continue to live in the community.

Secure, Elegant Home and Garden

Cedarhurst features include:

- Four self-contained wings with six residents per wing
- Generously sized private bedrooms with three-piece ensuite bathrooms
- A family-sized kitchen adjacent to each wing where staff, assisted by residents, prepare home-cooked meals
- Spacious great rooms with fireplace and piano
- A secure ground floor garden and upper terrace which residents can use daily
- A large group activity room augmented by small welcoming craft areas
